The Business Promotion Campaign to promote Dacono businesses is underway. He reported on the proposed United Power street light project and bringing power to the city building, we would need to submit a letter to use undergrounding money to pay for these projects. He reported on the new PHO, still in Safer at Home Phase, and how it affects Pavilion rentals and the Splash Pad, he asked Council for direction on opening up the Splash Pad. Racing venues can open without spectators. We have an Event Permit that is required for the race tracks. We would put a disclaimer that would require the venues to comply with the current PHO's that are in place.
