Clean-Out Day Tips

- ◆ Residents **must** obtain a voucher from City Hall– no vouchers issued at the landfill.
- ◆ Residents can dispose of bulk waste items free of charge with **voucher only** on Saturday, May 16.
- ◆ Senior citizens 65 and older or those with a disability can contact Dacono City Hall for assistance.

obtain one voucher from Dacono City Hall for free disposal of one load of large bulk items. This voucher must be obtained at Dacono City Hall between Friday, May 1 and Friday, May 15 by 12:00 p.m. The City will offer extended evening hours to obtain a voucher on Monday, May 11 until 6:00 p.m. Only one voucher per household will be issued. On Saturday, May 16 residents can take their load of large, bulk items to the landfill during normal business hours. The voucher must be presented to the gate attendant or landfill charges will apply. Residents 65 years of age or older or those with a disability, can contact Dacono City Hall and request assistance with their bulk waste disposal. Contact Mandy Ross at (303) 833-2317 ext. 121. Severe Weather Awareness

Tips to Help You Prepare for Spring Weather

Did you know that there are 20 million thunderstorms in the U.S. per year? According to READY-Colorado, thunderstorms are a normal precursor to hazards such as lightning, hail, wind, floods and even tornadoes. They are quite prevalent along the Front Range to the eastern plains during the spring and summer. The typical thunderstorm is 15 miles in diameter and lasts an average of 30 minutes.

Lightning can occur anywhere there is a thunderstorm, and can even strike miles away from the storm. Looking at where lightning occurs helps describe where the most prevalent thunderstorm activity is in Colorado. Lightning causes an average of 55-60 fatalities and 400 injuries each year. These incidents are most common during summer afternoons and evenings. Familiarizing yourself with the terms below may help with what to expect so you can properly prepare.

- ◆ **Severe Thunderstorm Watch** — Severe thunderstorms are possible in and near the watch area. Stay informed and be ready to act if a severe thunderstorm warning is issued.
- ◆ **Severe Thunderstorm Warning** — Severe weather has been reported by spotters or indi-

cated by radar. Warnings indicate imminent danger to life and property.

- ◆ **30/30 Lightning Rule** — You can tell how close you are to a lightning strike by counting the seconds between seeing the flash and hearing the thunder. For every five seconds you count, the lightning is one mile away. If you see a flash and instantly hear the thunder, the lightning strike is very close.

Despite the risk, everyone can take steps in preparing for severe weather. Be ready for severe weather this season. Register to receive weather alerts from both the City of Dacono Blackboard Connect and Weld County. You can register your home phone, cellular phone or an email address. 
